



Tour 04 – Tracking Tour in the Pantanal – 6 days / 4 nights

Day 1: Cuiabá Airport – UeSo Pantanal Lodge

After collecting your luggage at the airport, our guide will be waiting for you with a «UeSo Pantanal Lodge» sign. We'll then head off on a roughly 100 km drive to Poconé, followed by another 38 km along the famous Transpantaneira dirt road to the UeSo Pantanal Lodge. On the way, we hope you'll already spot some wildlife—caimans, capybaras, maybe even jabiru storks and many bird species. After check-in at the lodge, a buffet meal awaits you depending on your arrival time.

Please note: if you arrive in Cuiabá after 10:30 a.m., no lunch will be served; if after 5:30 p.m., no dinner will be available. In such cases, we'll gladly provide a packed meal.

After lunch, there's time for a siesta, followed by a walking safari to spot wildlife. If you like, we also offer an exciting night walk after dinner to search for nocturnal animals—don't forget your flashlight!

Day 2: UeSo Pantanal Lodge

At around 5:00 a.m., we begin our sunrise walk—an amazing natural experience. Enjoy a coffee or tea beforehand. After breakfast, we'll go on a horseback ride (or mule ride)—just like the Pantaneiros have done for generations. No riding experience is necessary. You can help with saddling and unsaddling, and we provide mandatory riding helmets. Lunch is served as a buffet at the lodge.

In the late afternoon, after a siesta, we'll go on a vehicle safari along the Transpantaneira. The Pantanal always has surprises in store—we hope to spot many birds, including the Tuiuiú (jabiru stork) and caimans. With a bit of luck, we might even encounter a tapir or an anteater. Afterwards, we return to the lodge for dinner.

Day 3: UeSo Pantanal Lodge

After breakfast, we head out on a peaceful boat tour. To avoid disturbing wildlife, our boats are paddled by hand rather than motor-powered. You're welcome to help paddle. This quiet approach lets us get closer to shy birds. Of course, life jackets are provided.

After lunch, you can relax by the pool. Later, we'll go on a short walk to one of the observation towers to spot monkeys. You're welcome to scatter some corn and salt on the trail. Dinner will again be served buffet-style at the lodge. Optional: After dinner, we offer another night walk to look for nocturnal animals.

Day 4: UeSo Pantanal Lodge

After breakfast, we'll set out on our second horseback (or mule) ride through the beautiful Pantanal. As always, riding helmets are mandatory. We hope for more memorable wildlife encounters. After lunch, take a break in a hammock or relax by the pool.

In the afternoon, you can join another boat tour on the nearby Rio Novo or Rio Claro. With some luck, you might see a family of giant otters and plenty of birds—or even a tapir. You're welcome to help with paddling, and life jackets are provided.

Day 5: UeSo Pantanal Lodge

At around 5:00 a.m., we head out on another early morning walking tour, increasing our chances of seeing wildlife thanks to the calm and quiet pace. After returning, we'll enjoy a hearty breakfast.

Afterwards, you're free to explore the marked trails on your own—just let your guide know beforehand.

In the late afternoon, we'll go on one more vehicle safari along the Transpantaneira in search of more wildlife.

Day 6: UeSo Pantanal Lodge – Cuiabá Airport

After a generous breakfast buffet at the lodge, you'll be transferred to Cuiabá airport.

If your flight is scheduled for the afternoon, you'll have the option to join a short morning walk or boat tour. In that case, the transfer will take place after lunch.

Note:

All scheduled activities will take place, though the order may change for organizational reasons.
