



Tour 07 – Nobres and the Pantanal – 5 days / 4 nights

Day 1: Cuiabá Airport – Pousada in Nobres (2 nights)

After collecting your luggage at the airport, your guide will be waiting with a sign that reads «UeSo Pantanal Lodge». From there, you'll drive straight to Bom Jardim, near the town of Nobres. (Note: Depending on your arrival time in Cuiabá, lunch or dinner may not be available. In such cases, we'll provide you with a packed lunch.) If you arrive around midday, you'll reach the partner lodge in Nobres by late afternoon.

After check-in, and depending on the time, you'll visit Lagoa das Araras. There, you can observe hundreds of birds—macaws, parakeets, parrots, and many more. Afterwards, return to the lodge.

Day 2: Pousada in Nobres – River Snorkeling – Duto do Quebó

Breakfast is served around 7:00 a.m. at the lodge. After breakfast, you'll enjoy the colorful natural scenery. Equipped with snorkel, life vest, mask, and water shoes, you'll head into the water—where beautiful aquatic life awaits you above and below the surface. Swim among fish like pintados, dorados, and many colorful aquarium species. Let the river carry you downstream while you enjoy more unforgettable moments. Lunch will be served back at the lodge.

In the afternoon, a very special river experience awaits. You'll float downstream on an inflatable tube along the Quebó River. This 2 km journey includes a 280-meter-long limestone cave called «Duto do Quebó». With your flashlight, you'll spot bats hanging from the ceiling and admire the impressive rock formations. You'll be equipped with sandals, life vest, tube, helmet, and flashlight. After exiting the river, you'll have the chance to visit a nearby natural stone bridge just 200 meters away—a lovely spot for swimming.

Day 3: Nobres – Transpantaneira – UeSo Pantanal Lodge (2 nights)

After breakfast, you'll set out toward Poconé. On the way, we'll stop at a gas station for a snack or a good cup of coffee. After passing the old gold mining town of Poconé, the journey continues along the world-famous Transpantaneira to the UeSo Pantanal Lodge. Along the route, we'll stop to observe wildlife and explore the diverse flora. Upon arrival and check-in, you'll enjoy a buffet lunch followed by some restful downtime.

In the late afternoon, you'll take a forest walk in the surrounding area. With a bit of luck, you may spot various bird species, capuchin monkeys, or even howler monkeys. A delicious buffet dinner will be served back at the lodge.

Day 4: UeSo Pantanal Lodge

Around 5:00 a.m., before breakfast, we'll head out on a sunrise walk. Coffee or tea will be available beforehand. Witness the awakening of the Pantanal—an unmatched natural experience. After breakfast, we'll go on a mule ride, the traditional mode of transport in the Pantanal. This activity is perfectly suitable for beginners. If you like, you can assist in saddling your mule. Riding helmets are mandatory and provided. A buffet lunch follows at the lodge.

After a midday rest, we'll head out on a boat tour along the nearby Rio Novo or Rio Claro. We use paddles rather than motors to avoid disturbing shy birds and animals. With a bit of luck, you may encounter a family of giant otters, a wide variety of birds, and perhaps even some mammals—maybe even a tapir.

Day 5: UeSo Pantanal Lodge – Cuiabá Airport

After the breakfast buffet at the lodge, you'll be transferred to the airport. If your flight departs in the afternoon, you'll have the option to join a walk or mule ride in the morning. In that case, the transfer will take place after lunch.

Note:

All scheduled activities will take place, but the order may change for organizational reasons.
